

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

Rural Municipality of Britannia No. 502

BYLAW NO. 02 - 2026

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF MUNICIPAL BYLAWS THAT DO NOT OTHERWISE PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES.

The council for the Rural Municipality of Britannia No. 502 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Short Title

1. The Bylaw may be referred to as the “General Penalty Bylaw”.

Definitions

2. “Municipality” shall mean the Rural Municipality of Britannia No. 502.
“Notice of Violation” shall mean, notice as listed in Schedule A.

Application of Bylaw

3. The payments and penalties outlined in Sections 4, 5, and 6 of this Bylaw shall apply only to contraventions of Bylaws of the Municipality, for which no penalty is provided.
 - 3.1 Where a Bylaw for the Municipality provides for a specific penalty for a contravention, that penalty takes precedence for that specific contravention.

Voluntary Payments and Penalties

4. In the case of a first offence, if the Municipality has reason to believe that a person or organization has contravened a provision of a Bylaw, the Municipality may serve on the person or organization, a Notice of Violation that states that the Municipality will accept a voluntary payment of a maximum of \$500.00 within thirty(30) days of service of the Notice of Violation. Voluntary payment of the penalty constitutes full satisfaction of the penalty for that particular offense only.
5. In the case of a second offence, if the Municipality has reason to believe that a person or organization has contravened a provision of a Bylaw, the Municipality may serve on the person or organization, a Notice of Violation that states that the Municipality will accept a voluntary payment of a maximum of \$1,000.00 within thirty(30) days of service of the Notice of Violation. Voluntary payment of the penalty constitutes full satisfaction of the penalty for that particular offense only.

6. In the case of a third offence, the offending person or organization is guilty of an offence under this Bylaw and liable to summary conviction as set out in Section 10 of this Bylaw.

7. Where the Municipality receives voluntary payment of the amount prescribed under Sections 4 or 5 within the time specified, the person receiving the Notice of Violation shall not be liable to prosecution for the alleged contravention.

8. Payment of any Notice of Violation does not necessarily exempt the person or organization from any other order pursuant to a Bylaw of the Municipality.

9. Every person who contravenes any provision of Sections 4 or 5 is guilty of an offence under this Bylaw and liable to summary conviction as set out in Section 10 of this Bylaw.

10. A person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction:
 - a) in the case of an individual, to a fine of not more than \$10,000;
 - b) in the case of a corporation, to a fine of not more than \$25,000; and
 - c) in the case of a continuing offence, to a maximum daily fine of not more than \$2,500 per day for each day during which the offence continues.

Severability

11. If an section or provision of this Bylaw is found to be invalid by a cour of competent jurisdiction, such invalid section or provision shall be severed, and the remainder of the Bylaw shall remain in force.

Repeal of Previous Bylaw

12. Bylaw No. 02-2009 is hereby repealed.

Coming Into Force

13. This Bylaw and its appendices shall come into force on the day of final passing.
