Items for recycle should be

CLEAN & DRY

And placed in Blue Bags

Paper/ Cardboard

- Newspaper & Flyers
- Magazines
- Printer & Writing paper
- Envelopes & Cards
- Boxes (Flattened & Emptied)
- Milk & Egg Cartons
- Juice Boxes/ Tetrapaks
- Books, Catalogues

Metal

- Cans (Food & Beverage)

Plastic

- Plastic Jugs
- Milk Jugs
- Dairy & Food Containers
- Beverage Bottles
- Soap & Shampoo Bottles

**** All items can be bagged together in
BLUE bags only**

**Black bags and grocery type bags will
not be accepted****

Heavy Materials Bin

- SHINGLES
- DRYWALL
- TREATED & PAINTED WOOD
- CERAMIC TOILETS, ETC.
- PLEASE REMOVE ALL INSULATION
FROM CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL

Clean Wood Pile

- NO TREATED WOOD
- NO PAINTED, LAMINATED
CHIPBOARD, PLYWOOD

THE ABOVE ITEMS MUST BE
SORTED

AND PLACED IN SEPARATE PILE.

Compactor Shed

- All non recyclable household
garbage must be bagged.
- All glass can be bagged with the
household garbage
- Bags must be light enough to be
carried and lifted into compactor.

Drop Off Rules

- All loads must be sorted.
- No mixed loads permitted.
- Residential use only.
- No commercial or contractors
refuse accepted
- Materials must be lifted and placed
in bins, NO dumping from trailers
or vehicles with hoists.
- No sweeping or cleaning out of
trailers, vehicles or containers on
Transfer Station property.
- Visitors are required to lift their
own materials into bins.

All waste must be placed in the appropriate
areas as directed by the Transfer Station
Attendant.

Freezers/ Refrigerators

Metals

- To be put in the metals pile, some items containing metal may need to be broken down

Wire - Wire only – Wooden posts must be removed

Used Oil, Paint, Antifreeze

- Used oil **MUST** be put into the used oil tank, containers emptied and lids removed.
- Filters to be put into black filter containers
- Paint
- Antifreeze

Grain bags – Rolled wrapped with twine

Baler Twine – Clean. No netting

Batteries - Put on pallet at battery shed

POP CANS - A donation bin for recyclable cans and bottles is located on site, Proceeds go to the Hillmond Canscate Program.

- **Rocks**
- **Rubble**
- **Soil**
