THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BRITANNIA NO. 502

BYLAW NO. 19-2020

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 18 - 2014 KNOWN AS THE LLOYDMINTSER PLANNING DISTRICT COMMISSION ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Britannia No. 502, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 18-2014 as follows:

- 1. By amending Section 3 Administration, by adding the following after subsections 13.15.4:
 - 13.6 Holding Provision
 - 13.6.1 Any land designated on the Zoning District Map with the holding symbol "H" shall be subject to a holding provision in accordance with Section 71 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.
 - 13.6.2 The purpose of the holding provision shall be to enable Council to manage development and subdivision proposals in phases.
 - (1) The application and management of the holding provision shall be at Councils discretion;
 - (2) Council may rezone and manage development and subdivisions in phases by designating portions of land with a holding symbol "H" with any zoning district.
 - (3) The holding provision and symbol shall mean:
 - (a) New development shall be restricted in the area subject to the holding provision; and
 - (b) Existing uses may continue, subject to the Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw development and subdivision standards
 - (4) The holding designation may only be removed by amendment of the Zoning bylaw. All Bylaws removing the holding designation shall conform to the Official Community Plan and the provision of the *Planning and Development Act, 2007.*
- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the approval of the Minister of Government Relations.
