Core Samples and Gravel Pile Measurements Required for Guest Controls Project

CRUSH: That we instruct administration to acquire core material samples within the Guest Control Road on Range Road 3273 from Township Road 500 to Township Road 504. These samples should be taken where failures have been repaired and other strategic locations within the road to ensure a proper base is prepared prior to the chip seal being applied. The R.M. of Britannia No. 502 acknowledges the price quoted by Harlow J. Fox of Kowal Construction Alta Ltd. of \$ 8.00 per cubic metre of material excavated for failure repairs. Further, that we instruct administration to have pile measurements done prior to work commencing and after work is completed, to determine the amount of aggregate used on the Guest Control Road. This measurement will be utilized as a baseline measurement to compare with the contractor's scale measurements.
