NOBLE: That council submits the following resolution to the SARM (Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities):

Whereas, the RIRG (Rural Integrated Roads for Growth) program and its previous program, MREP (Municipal Roads for the Economy Program) were established and maintained to provide funding to municipalities that require financial assistance to be put towards infrastructure to help aid economic development is areas that are experiencing economic development.

Whereas, the RIRG program changed the funding structure to be a maximum of \$500,000 per year instead of the previous \$750,000 per year, to allow for more municipalities to participate in the program. Whereas, as per section 343 (1) of the Municipalities Act, it is council's responsibility to maintain the rural municipalities road infrastructure in a reasonable state of repair, having regard for the character of the road. Whereas, some locations within Saskatchewan rural municipalities require road infrastructure to be at a different standard than others to combat the amount of daily traffic and type of traffic. Be it resolved, that the RIRG Program Management Board remove pavement as an ineligible expense through the Rural Integrated Roads For Growth Program.
