BYLAW No. 05-2026

A BYLAW OF THE R.M. OF BRITANNIA NO. 502 TO AMEND BYLAW No. 18-2014 KNOWN AS THE LLOYDMINSTER PLANNING DISTRICT COMMISSION ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Britannia No. 502, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw 18-2014 as follows:

1. PART 4 – GENERAL REGULATIONS, Section 4.10 Regulations for Signs and Billboards, Sub-section 4.10.4 Signs in Other Districts is amended by deleting clause (1) in its entirety and replacing it with

“

(1) Signs and billboards that are not located in a highway sign corridor or a residential district, and that advertise agricultural commercial uses, farm or home based businesses, the principal use of a site or the principal products offered for sale on a site, are subject to the following requirements:

(a) No more than two (2) signs shall be permitted on the premises.

(b) No sign shall be in the excess of 8.0 m² in sign face area, but the two permitted signs may be combined and the total sign face area shall not exceed 16 m². Each sign may be double faced.

~~(c) No sign shall be illuminated unless the source of light is steady and suitably shielded.~~ Removed by Bylaw Amendment 01-2021.

(d) The maximum height of any sign shall be 8.0 metres.”

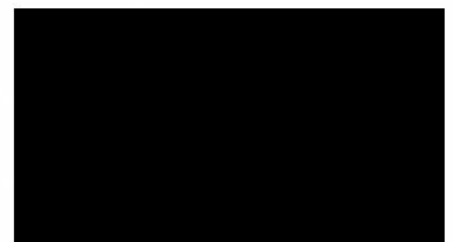
2. Formatting of all amendment content shall reflect the established scheme in the existing Zoning Bylaw.

This bylaw shall become effective on the date of approval of the Minister of Government Relations.

Read a First time, this 25th day of February, 2026.

Read a Second time, this 29th day of April, 2026.

Read a Third and final time, this 29th day of April, 2026.
